





This is your final 4 Villages reminder of our Annual Show to be held on Saturday 2rd September in the Great Yeldham Reading Room which is behind the old phone box for those newcomers to the village. You don't need to be a member of the society to enter, or even live in the village the more the merrier. There are cash prizes up for grabs as well as cups and trophies. The different classes cover homegrown fruit & vegetables, flowers & pot plants, flower arranging, cookery, home produced eggs, arts & craft, photography and children's classes. All exhibits must be staged between 9 and 10.30am on the day of the show as then the hall will be closed for judging. The Show then opens for public viewing at 2 pm with teas, a raffle and finally the prize giving at 3.00pm. Please do come and give us your support.

Completed entry forms (available from me if required) can be handed in to Sarah Mackinnon at Stonebridge House, next to the old Post Office, emailed to joannacwilliams@btinternet.com, or given in person on Wednesday 30th August in the Reading Room between 7-8pm or on the morning of the show between 9.00 -10.30. All members have been sent a schedule of the different classes. Please enter what you can; this is a friendly, amateur, village show but there is no show without entries.

August is usually one of the hottest months of the year - making watering in your garden essential, especially for containers. Try to use stored rain water from water butts or grey water wherever possible. Careful use of suitable potting media and placement of containers out of direct sunlight also helps retain moisture. August is also the time to prune *Wisteria* and summer-flowering shrubs such as lavender once they've finished flowering. Remember to regularly deadhead flowering plants as soon as they are past their best. The simplest method is just to pinch off the faded bloom using finger and thumb. By September you should be picking autumn raspberries and harvesting any remaining potatoes.

Looking ahead to October, we will be holding a general knowledge quiz with buffet supper on Saturday 21st October. More details to follow.

We are delighted that the café has proved to be so popular for so many people and we hope that you will be able to come along on **7 September** to celebrate our 2nd birthday with us.


