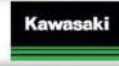

Crisis can strike unexpectedly, whether it be struggling to keep up with mortgage rates or dealing with a family member's illness. With the increasing cost of living, it is easy to find yourself sacrificing basic needs like food to make ends meet. It's important to note that food insecurity does not discriminate, and everyone is at risk.

Between April 2022 and March 2023, Braintree Area Foodbank provided **9,473** food parcels to local residents, with **4,292** going to children. This marks an **189.79%** increase in the last five years. Shockingly, one in five visitors in December came from working households.

Our mission is to provide comprehensive support to our district beyond just food. We encourage members of the community to keep an eye on their neighbours and seek support if necessary. This is why we have appointed a Community Outreach Officer to help us reach those in need who might not know the support available.

If you, or someone you know, is struggling to afford the essentials, we are here to help.

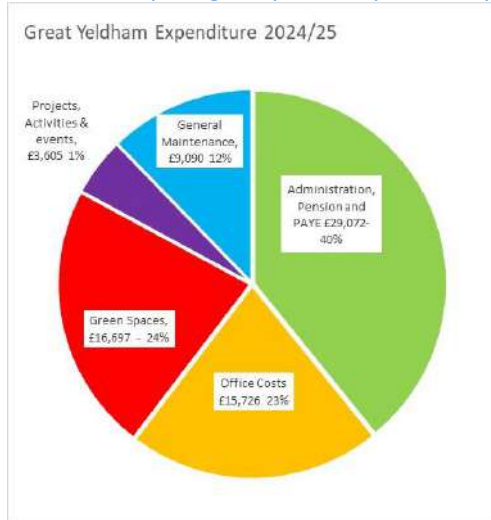

Great Yeldham Parish Council Precept 2024/25

The precept, our part of the Council Tax, is used to provide facilities and services in the village. We continue to maintain the green spaces, verges, footpaths; the Lawn Cemetery, Natural Burial Grounds and St Andrews Churchyard; the play park and the Sports and Recreation Ground; the provision of the Handyman Service and general maintenance costs for the upkeep of the village; and essential administration costs to ensure that the Parish Council fulfils its legal obligations and financial responsibilities.

Local government is currently facing significant financial pressures and unfortunately Great Yeldham is not immune to them. We know these challenges are felt by many of our residents too. However, given the current economic outlook and demand pressures, it is something we are unable to avoid. The Parish Council has continued to find further efficiency savings across the budget, where it can. Yet, there are some inflationary increases which are unavoidable and additional commitments including £1,200 to hire the village hall for the Outreach Post Office Service; maintenance of Bowtells Meadow when transferred to the Parish Council estimated at £4k; increased costs for grounds maintenance works including grass cutting, verges, footpaths (maintained by the parish), hedges and tree works.

At the Parish Council meeting held on 11th January 2024, Councillors agreed from April 2024 the precept will increase to £59,799, which represents the Parish element on Council Tax Band D Annual Charge of £88.91 (a rise of £7.91 from 2023/24). The Parish Council will continue to identify savings and welcomes suggestions from residents. Further budget information can be found at <https://greatyeldhampc.co.uk/precept>

What a start to the Spring term – baby news! Mrs Dunwell (who is the teacher of Apple Class) and her husband had their baby. Mrs Quince (teacher of Oak class) and her husband are expecting their baby in the early summer! Congratulations to them both.

The children have all had a good start to their terms and are excited about the new topics on offer.

In Mulberry Class, the children's learning is linked to the question "Are we there yet?". This topic links map work, different vehicles and modes of transport. As well as this, the children follow a carefully planned structure of phonic lessons to start their reading journey.

Bowtell's Meadow Update

At the time of writing this update, the legal process to transfer ownership of the Meadow to the Parish Council is still in progress. We hope to be able to confirm soon that the process has been completed. We will have to take account of the proposed work in Churchfields by Essex County Council Highways, which will clearly have an impact on our plans to develop the Meadow. We will update you when we know more about that, but we do still want to make progress where we can.

Our ambitions remain as previously shared:

- To develop Bowtell's Meadow as an asset to the village, to help promote our collective health and well-being
- To keep the Meadow mowed, tidy and accessible at all times (we are currently out to tender for a new mowing contract)
- To install new benches and picnic tables (with input from the Men's Shed on this)
- To plant some new trees and flowers in the Meadow (hopefully with help from the children at the school as well as from volunteers within the village)
- To install a new perimeter path
- To install a range of new playground equipment and create a new larger play area for all age groups.

The Parish Council agreed in January to work with a company called **eibe** as our preferred partner to install the new playground equipment and perimeter path, as well as assisting us in taking forward the overall development of the site.

We will arrange a public meeting at the Reading Room in the next few months to share the playground equipment plans in detail and get your feedback and comments. We will also provide further updates in the 4 Villages Magazine, on the village notice board and on Facebook and the Parish Council web site.

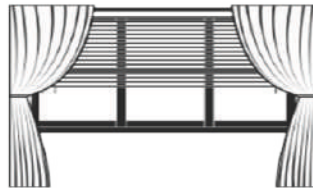
